European Association for Horse Assisted Education 2010 Conference

Shannon was invited to present the workshop “The Shadow of a Leader: What Shadow Do You Cast?” Using principles of natural horsemanship as a metaphor to connecting with others, Shannon spoke to over 70 participants from 20 different countries. After the three-day event, the Knapps facilitated an additional workshop introducing “Equine Assisted Practices & the Horse Sense Approach to Horse and Human Development.” Participants engaged in interactive activities with horses and learned key concepts of natural horsemanship through the Knapp’s Horse Sense Approach. The European Conference’s theme was “New Learning from Ancient Wisdom.”
